Amended temporary law of the Social Security Corporation Law Law No. 26 for the year 2009 Published in the official Gazette on October 15, 2009 in issue number 4991

We Abdullah II Ben Al Hussein, King of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan.

Upon paragraph 11 of article 94 of the Constitution and based on the Cabinet's decision of October 6, 2009, and upon article 31 of the Constitution, we endorse the following temporary law and order putting it into effect temporarily. We order adding it to the state's laws and refer it to the Parliament in its first meeting:

Amended temporary law of the Social Security Corporation Law Law Nom. 26 for the year 2009

Article (1)—The law shall be named (the amended law of the Social Security Corporation Law for the year 2009) and is read as law No. (19) for the year 2001 referred to in hereunder as the original law as one law and it goes into effect upon publishing in the official Gazette.

Article (2)—Paragraph (17) of the original law is amended by adding paragraph (H) to it that stipulates:

(H1)—Upon this law, salaries subject to the Social Security Corporation deductions should not exceed JD5,000 monthly.

(H2)—Those insured whose salaries exceed JD5,000 by January, 1, 2009 are excluded from being subject to article (1) of this paragraph. Any increase in their salaries after the above mentioned date shall not be taken into consideration.

Article (3)—Article No. 43 is amended in the original law by annulling paragraph (H) from it.

Article (4)—Article 44 in the original law is amended by adding paragraph (O) to it that states:

O—This paragraph does not apply to those insured and covered for the first time by the Social Security Corporation after October, 6, 2009.
